**Friday** Focus Area: Nuclear Medicine

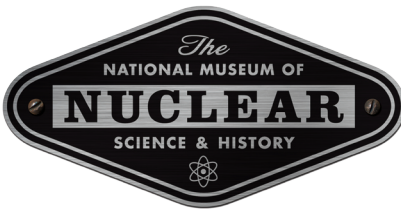

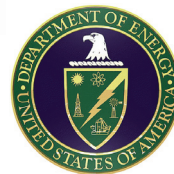
